Without the proper shepherd the sheep go astray. Just like the sheep which go astray today we find people going away from the righteous and True path. Sometimes the sheep wander away from the shepherd; some of them fall into pits, some in the valleys, some are attacked and killed by the wild animals, some of them get entangled in the thorny bushes and yet few of them die for want of food and water. All these hazards the sheep face because there is no good shepherd for them to guide and protect them.

"But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd."

-Matthew 9:36.

A good shepherd is troubled to find one of his sheep in distress. Similarly when we are in great trouble, our blessed Lord with His great compassion comes to protect and lead us in the right way.
